Pecanwood Golf Club is proud to announce that it has entered into a strategic brand partnership with steel specialists Omni Struct Nkosi.

By night, the eye-catching feature is lit

by submerged lights.

By day, it complements the vista of Pecanwood's immaculate greens, against the backdrop of the magnificent Magaliesberg mountains and the waters of the Hartbeespoort Dam.

Now there's even more for golfers to enjoy on a course that is home to a rich and diverse bird population and also boasts long-established shrubberies, mini-wetlands and far in excess of 4 500 fully-grown trees.

"This fountain is the first step in our and Omni Struct Nkosi's joint commitment in enhancing the look, feel and experience for the golfers who play at Pecanwood regularly, as well as our many international visitors and players from other parts of the country," says Payet.

Other improvements include the placing of water coolers and refuse bins at strategic sites on the course, as well as scorecards, tee's, bottled water and range balls which contributes to a world class golfing experience.

"We love golf and we're passionate about Pecanwood," is how Omni Struct Nkosi director Gerry Boom explains the motivation behind the partnership.

Dave van Asche, a fellow director, says the branding, reputation and stature of Pecanwood and Omni Struct Nkosi - in their respective fields - are mutually complementary and lay the foundation for a highly successful partnership in the years to come.
